Summary:

The Downtown Women's Center (DWC) has partnered with Daylight Community Development and the Decro Corporation as the operator of NoHo 5050, a new housing development in North Hollywood. Construction on the 40-unit development is set to commence with a public groundbreaking celebration, with special remarks expected from Los Angeles City Councilmember Paul Krekorian (CD-2). NoHo 5050 will provide 32 one-bedroom units and eight two-bedroom units for individuals and families, including trauma survivors, with on-site case management and supportive services, a learning center, a community room, landscaped open space, bicycle storage, and a laundry room.
